## Method

- **1** Collect petals from any colourful flowers you can find and place them in a bowl
- 2 Grind the petals with a pestle
- **3** Cover the petals with boiling water (just enough to cover them)
- 4 Leave the mixture overnight and then strain the petal tea through a cheese cloth
- 5 The mixture is now ready to use!
- 6 Encourage the children to dip their paintbrushes in the ink and paint a picture with their flower ink


