- 4 Discuss with the function of each body part with the children and how each part helps bees to be bees!


## **Learning Outcomes**

- Learners will be enabled to record from first-hand experience and from imagination, and to select their own ideas to use in their work.










Wings	Eye	Legs	Antenna	Proboscis
