## Method

- 1 Use play dough to create your own microbes
- 2 Decide what type of microbe you have made: fungi, bacteria or virus
- 3 Decide whether it is a good microbe or a bad microbe
- 4 See below for some examples

## Learning Outcomes

- 1 Learners will develop an understanding of what microbes are;
- 2 Learners will understand that some microbes are good, and some microbes are bad;
- 3 Learners will appreciate the diversity of microbes and how they vary, visually;
- 4 Learners will use playdough to create microbes, enhancing their motor skills, whilst using their imagination.
