## Method

- Work your way through the information sheet below
- 2 Ask the children to complete the tasks

## **Learning Outcomes**

- 1 Learners will develop a basic understanding of vaccines;
- 2 Learners will understand that vaccines have been used for many years, and are safe and vital for preventing disease;
- Learners will discover that they have likely already had many vaccines themselves, and will learn which ones they have had;
- 4 Learners will understand why it is important for vaccine deployment to tackle American Foulbrood in Honeywood.






Sometimes, germs like bacteria and viruses can get in our bodies and make us sick!

This means you will not get sick if you meet the bug in the future.












You got lots of your vaccines when you were a baby.
